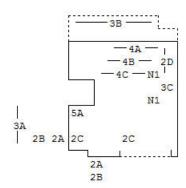

This inspection is limited to the visible and accessible portions of the structure as noted on the diagram only. A "Supplemental" inspection will disclose further information about the original inspection report and will reference the original report # and date. Supplemental reports are issued when additional damage is discovered during course of repair or when further inspection is recremended on the original report. A "Reinspection" report will describe work completed by others and will reference the original report # and date. All findings will pertain to infestation and/or infection by wood destroying organisms and does not include reference to other structural pests such as, but not limited to, rats, mice, bees, ants, bats, cockroaches etc. This inspection does not render opinions as to the condition of roofing, heating, air conditioning or electrical. If such information is desired, we suggest that a qualified home inspector be contacted for inspection of these items. Inspection of wood fences is not included in this report. This company does not render any opinion as to the water tightness of the roof, if such information is desired parties of interest should contact a licensed roofing contractor.

This is a wood destroying pest and organism report: Not a building inspection report, therefore no opinion is being rendered regarding the structural integrity of the building.

The following areas were not inspected, as indicated in section #1990, paragraph (j) of the Structural Pest Control Act and Rules and Regulation: Furnished interiors, inaccessible attics, insulated attics, and portions thereof; The interior of hollow wall; Spaces between a floor or porch deck and the ceiling or soffit below; Stall showers over finished buttresses and similar areas to which there is no access without defacing or tearing out lumber, masonry and finished work, built-in cabinet work: Floor beneath coverings, areas where storage conditions or locks makes inspection impractical, and areas which require walking on the roof in order to access.

SECTION 1: Contains items where there is evidence of active infestation, infection or conditions that have resulted in or from infestation or infection.

SECTION 2: Section 2 items are conditions deemed likely to lead to infestation or infection, but where no visible evidence of such was found.

<u>FURTHER INSPECTION:</u> Further inspection items are defined as recommendations to inspect areas(s) which during the original inspection, did not allow the inspector access to complete the inspection and cannot be defined as section 1 or section 2.

SECTION I:

(2) DRYWOOD TERMITES

2A. Section: 1

FINDING: Evidence of drywood termites was noted at the eaves.

RECOMMENDATION: Seal and fumigate the entire structure with a registered fumigant sulfuryl fluoride in accordance

with the manufacturer's label. Mask over or remove the termite pellets. This company will exercise all due caution, but cannot be held responsible for damage to plants, TV antennas, or roofing due

to the fumigation.

NOTE: In order to achieve an adequate ground seal for fumigation, the owner will need to clear any

gravel, decorative bark and mulch one foot from the foundation around the entire perimeter of the structure. Heavy plant growth will need to be cut back away from exterior walls. In some cases where the base of the plant is up against the foundation the plant will need to be covered with the tarps which will jeopardize the plant. If these preparations are not performed by the owner,

additional charges may be incurred.

Additional charges may be incurred if the occupant does not bag their food items in the special

bags provided.

Fumigations are guaranteed for 6 years from the date of completion.

2B. Section:1

FINDING: Drywood termite damage was noted at the eave framing.

RECOMMENDATION: Replace the damaged portions of the eaves.

2C. Section: 1

FINDING: Evidence of Drywood termite infestation was found at the attic framing.

RECOMMENDATION: Refer to item number 2A.

(3) FUNGUS/DRYROT

3A. Section: 1

FINDING: Fungus damage was found at the support posts and the plywood siding.

RECOMMENDATION: Replace the damaged portions of the support posts and siding.

Wood fillers such as bondo are not an acceptable means of repair.

3B. Section: 1

FINDING: Fungus damage, drywood termite damage and dampwood termite damage exists throughout the

wood deck.

RECOMMENDATION: Replace the entire deck with new materials. This repair will require cutting off the original

cantelevered deck joists and installing a ledger to the rear wall of the structure in order to support

the new joists.

NOTE: If the damage is found to extend into the floor joists such findings will be noted on a supplemental

report.

3C. Section: 1

FINDING: Earth contact and fungus damage were noted at in the plywood soil retainer in the subarea.

RECOMMENDATION: Contact a licenced concrete contractor to install a proper concrete foundation in place of the soil

retainer.

SECTION II:

(4) OTHER FINDINGS

4A. Section: 2

FINDING: Water stains and evidence of water intrusion were noted at the interior wall which appears to have

been caused by leakage from the cantelevered deck joists.

RECOMMENDATION: Refer to item 3B.

(4) OTHER FINDINGS

4B. Section: 1

FINDING: Evidence of Dampwood termite infestation was found at the substructure framing.

RECOMMENDATION: Refer to item number 2A.

(4) OTHER FINDINGS

4C. Section: 2

FINDING: Cellulose debris, form boards/stakes were noted in the subarea.

RECOMMENDATION: Remove the cellulose debris of a rakable size and the form boards/stakes from the subarea. If it

is found that it is impractical to remove the boards/stakes, treat the embedded wood with (Timbor) Disodium octaborate tetrahydrate, an approved fungicide, in accordance with the manufacturer's

label.

NOTE: IF IT IS FOUND THAT DURING THE REMOVAL OF THE DEBRIS AND/OR BOARDS/STAKES

THAT THE WOOD IS INFESTED WITH SUBTERRANEAN TERMITES, A SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT WILL BE ISSUED AND ANY FINDINGS AND ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL BE

LISTED.

(5) FURTHER INSPECTION

5A. Section 3:

FINDING: The storage area was inaccessible for inspection due to a locked door.

RECOMMENDATION: Inspect the storage area after access can be gained and list any findings on a supplemental

report.

NOTE 1: Water stains were noted in the attic indicating previous roof leakage, current leakage could not be determined. Parties of interest should satisfy themselves as to the condition of the roof prior to the close of escrow.
