- The lush, front yard provides a great place to relax and engage with friends and neighbors. The birds sing in the native greenery in the morning and the hummingbirds fly in the afternoon. This also serves as a great space for children and/or a pet.
- The neighborhood is great and full of friendly families. We often walk to the local parks on Farrell Ave and Rindge Lane to meet up with friends or take the dog for a walk. The home is also a few blocks from Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach Elementary schools and Manhattan Beach Middle school and the many shops on Artesia Blvd. A further walk or short bike ride brings you to Polliwog Park on Manhattan Beach Blvd which hosts Shakespeare by the Sea and summer concerts. It makes for a relaxing summer evening to grab a lawn chair, stop by the Trader Joes next to the park for picnic supplies and to enjoy a performance.
- The neighborhood is also ideal for a run of any length before or after the work day. A short run leads you to the bike path that stretches the length of the neighborhood, or can bring you to the Aviation track for laps. For a longer adventure, it is both beautiful and peaceful to run through Manhattan Beach down to the Strand and be greeted by sunrise on the way back to the house.

- The downstairs den is an excellent focal point for the family. It is spacious with a
