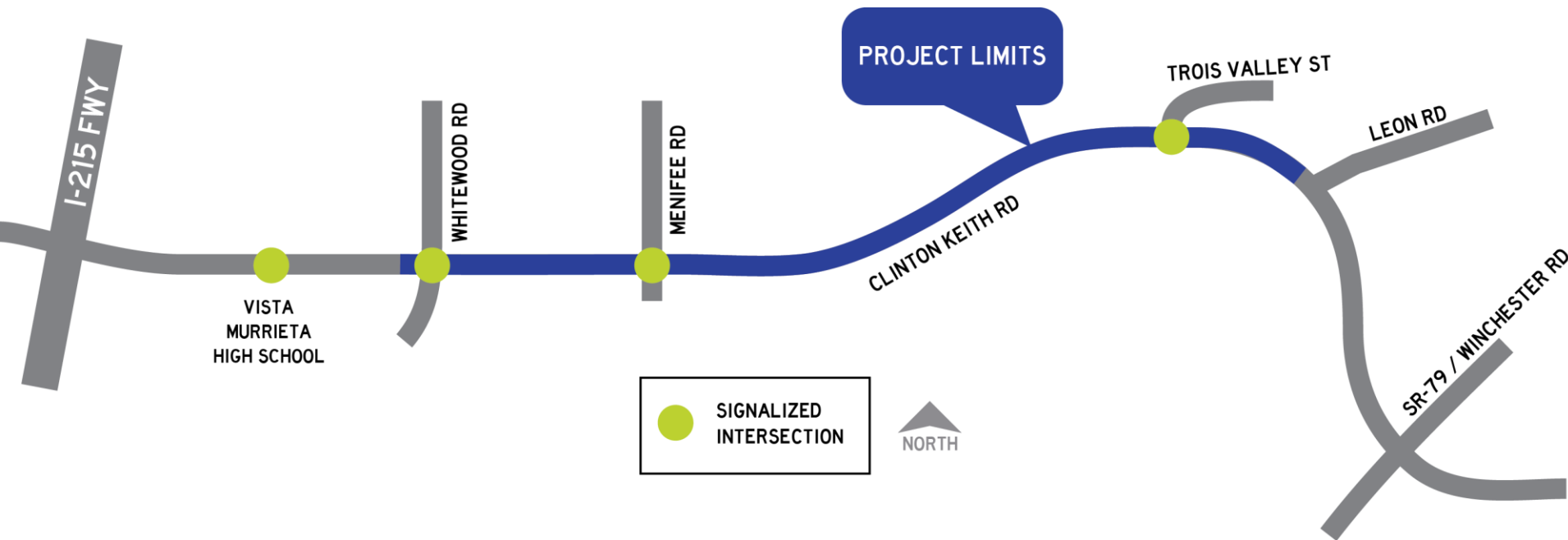

- ❑ Building a 4 Lane Urban Arterial With Ultimate Buildout to 6 Lanes as Funds Become Available
- ❑ Improvements Between Whitewood Road and Leon Road
- ❑ Contract Bid Amount: \$23,441,273
- ❑ Construction Starts March 2016
- ❑ Work Will Continue For 18 to 24 Months Weather Permitting

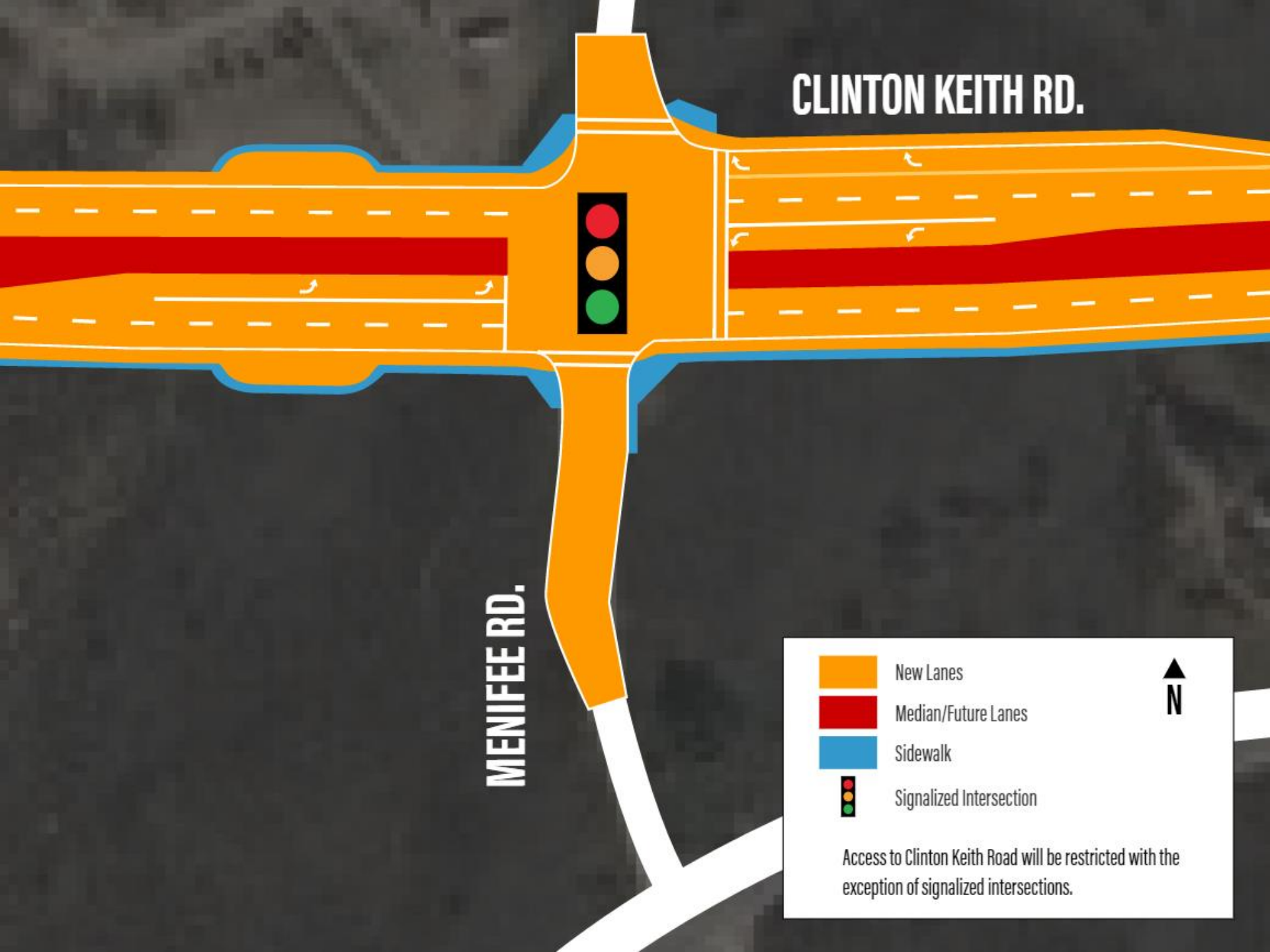

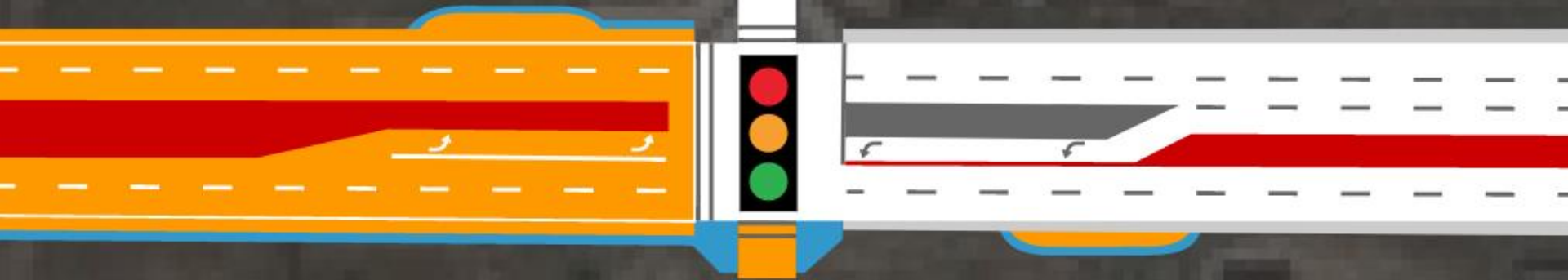

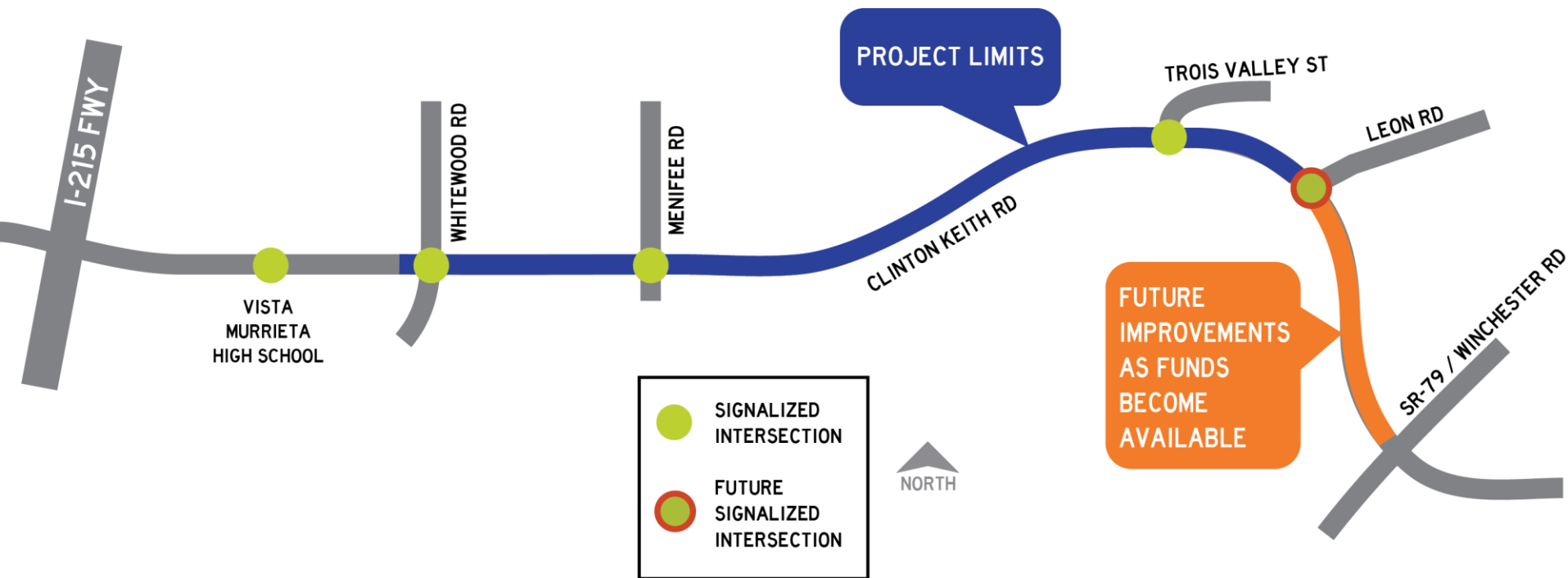

Edison Pole Relocation

- ❑ County workforce completed grading for Edison pole relocation during Fall of 2015
- ❑ Edison relocation work has started and will continue during construction of the road.

Vegetation Removal



- ▶ LIVE GOATS were being used as an environmentally friendly way to clear vegetation within the project limits
- ▶ This method reduced the impacts to the community while also encouraging birds to nest in other locations
- ▶ Goats completed their task in March 2016.

Contractor Information

- ▶ Sukut Construction – Santa Ana, CA
- ▶ 18 to 24 Month Construction Schedule
- ▶ Work hours 7 am – 6 pm M–F
 - No weekend work anticipated at this time

Access During Construction

- ▶ Access will be provided for residents via Greenberg Place, Arendt Lane, Avenida Manana
- ▶ Roads will be graded at Arendt Lane and Greenberg Place to provide access to Whitewood Road (signalized intersection)
- ▶ Local residents will have access to Los Alamos via Menifee Road

Access During Construction



Blast Excavation

- ▶ A portion of the job may require the contractor to perform blast excavation
- ▶ Similar process was used on SR-79 in the Winchester area
- ▶ Emergency responders will be positioned during blast operations to reduce response time
- ▶ Notices will be distributed to the school and residents prior to each blast event

Outreach Campaign

- ▶ Stakeholders / First Responders, School District Transportation and local transit were briefed prior to the utility relocation work
- ▶ Public meetings were held prior to the start of construction
- ▶ Regular meetings / briefings will be held as necessary to keep all apprised of project milestones
- ▶ Ongoing coordination will take place between the City of Murrieta, the County of Riverside, School District Management, and Emergency Services

Outreach Campaign Continued

- ▶ Website **RCProjects.org** will be updated and maintained
- ▶ Collateral material will be distributed to communities impacted by the project

- ▶ Project information will be disseminated to local media
