

Directions to 24924 Houston Dr, Crestline CA 92325

Thank you SO MUCH for reading these directions. This tells me you're smart, and that we'd do a great deal together! Here is my advice: The road is narrow, and goes from paved to unmaintained dirt to washed out and rutted. Once you get to the washed out part you'll definitely need a 4x4 (not all wheel drive) that is lifted. There are ruts in the final part of the road that are almost a foot deep. If there is snow on the ground you won't see them, and you could get stuck. That's a big tow truck bill. I'm a local, I drive an AWD Ford Edge and I won't take my car on this road. If you follow my directions below, you'll get there. Be prepared to walk. Wear flat shoes with grip. The terrain changes and there's rocks. It's not far, but it is not a flat walk. Now, for the directions...!

Step one: From Crest Forest Drive turn onto Scenic View. Stay to the right. Seriously, no matter what, stay to the right. I don't care what your GPS says, it's going to be wrong. Anyway, you'll come to a section where the pavement stops and the road turns to dirt. This is reasonably flat, no problem. The dirt road will curve left, and you'll see a parking deck with a treehouse marked "25000". I park off the dirt road around here and then walk the rest of the way in.

Step two: As you walk down the road you'll come to a "T" intersection. There is a sharp switchback to the left, and you can visually identify this as there is a yellow fire hydrant and two tall, bright red poles. Take the switchback. It's a gentle downslope from here and the roadway fluctuates from dirt to gravel to dirt to a small bit of asphalt. You'll come to a section of the road that then becomes a full dirt road and there's a sign that reads "Not a Through Street". Congratulations, you're almost there!

Step three: Continue down the road. You'll come to a four way intersection. Bear right. The road here is deeply rutted, but you'll have a nice view of Lake Gregory to console you. Up ahead you'll see the road is blocked off by a chain, and to the right is an upslope dirt driveway, and the house.

The lockbox is on the railing at the first door you see, which is the side door. There should be a light on there – please leave it turned on.
