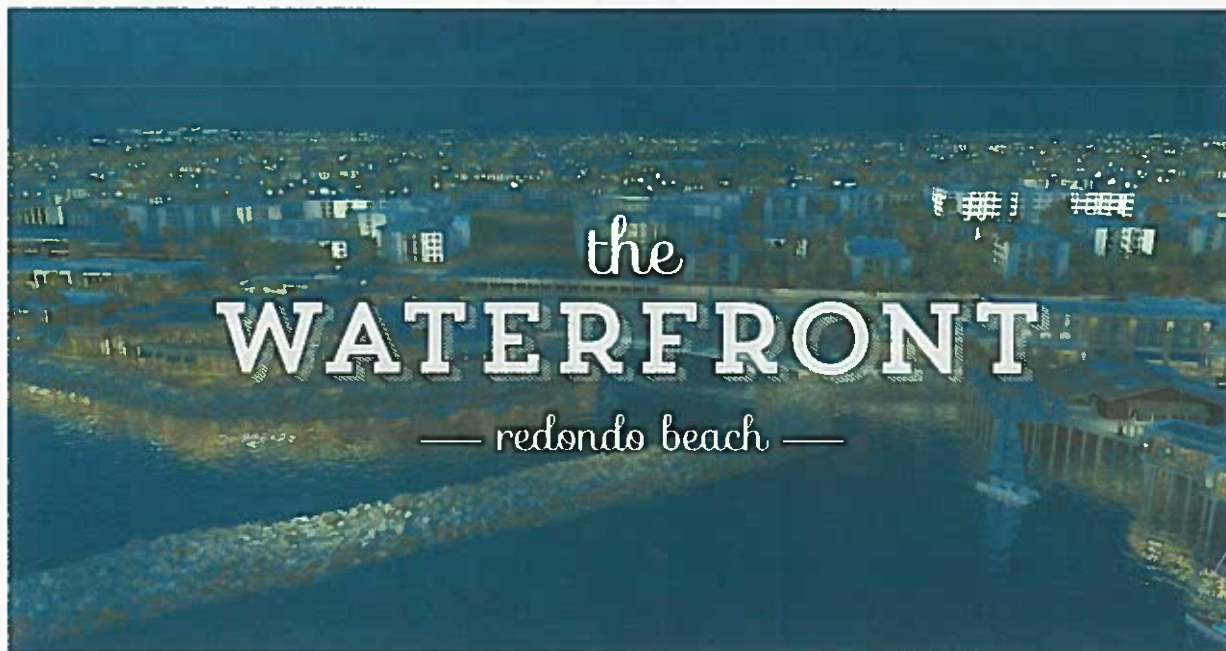

Public Gathering Places

Eleven acres of open space encompass the project. That's open space for gathering areas, art exhibitions, beachside concerts, yoga on the beach, summertime outdoor movies and other enjoyable community events. By reducing the parking footprint from over 500,000 square feet – as it stands currently – to approximately 160,000 square feet, there is increased area for park and open spaces.
