About Bixby Knolls:

The majority of homes in the area were custom-built between 1920 and 1940, providing a variety of home architecture.

Small shops and restaurants dot Atlantic Avenue and Long Beach Blvd between San Antonio and the 405 freeway. The neighborhood is also served by several nearby grocery stores (including Trader Joe's) and shopping centers.

Bixby Knolls has a very active and engaged local community. The area's Business Improvement Association sponsors a variety of social clubs (reading, walking, kids bike ride, etc), along with the incredibly popular First Fridays.

The Helen Borgers Theater, home to the Long Beach Shakespeare Company, and the Historical Society of Long Beach are both located on Atlantic Ave. On the west side of the neighborhood, adjacent to the Los Angeles River, is the large Virginia Country Club, which is also the location of the Rancho Los Cerritos historic site. And it is always fun to note that the area is renowned as a filming site for notable movies and shows (e.g. Ferris Bueller's Day Off, A Cinderella Story, Dexter).
