Shutoff valves and angle stops at kitchen or bathrooms sinks and toilets are not tested due to the possibility of leaking.

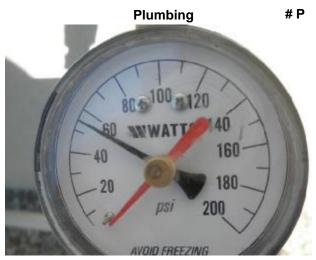
