

WHAT IS A WOOD DESTROYING PEST & ORGANISM INSPECTION REPORT?

Read this document, it explains the scope and limitations of a structural pest control inspection and a wood destroying pest organism inspection report.

A Wood Destroying Pest & Organism Inspection Report contains findings as to the presence or absence of evidence of wood destroying pests and organisms in visible and accessible areas and contains recommendations for correcting any infestations or infections found. The contents of Wood Destroying Pest & Organism Inspection Reports are governed by the Structural Pest Control Act and regulations.

This property was not inspected for the presence or absence of health related molds or fungi. By California law we are neither qualified, authorized nor licensed to inspect for health related molds or fungi. If you desire information about the presence or absence of health related molds, you should contact an industrial hygienist.

This structure was ___ was not _x__ furnished and unoccupied at the time of inspection. (Indicate with a check mark)

Some structures do not comply with building code requirements or may have structural, plumbing, electrical, mechanical, heating, air conditioning or other defects that do not pertain to wood destroying organisms. A Wood Destroying Pest & Organism Inspection Report does not contain information on such defects, if any, as they are not within the scope of the licenses of either the inspector or the company issuing a Wood Destroying Pest & Organism Inspection Report.

The Structural Pest Control Act requires inspection of only those areas which are visible and accessible at the time of inspection. Some areas of the structure are not accessible for inspection, such as the interior of hollow walls, spaces between floors, areas concealed by carpeting, built-in appliances, or cabinet work. Infestation or infections may be active in these areas without visible and accessible evidence. Areas that were not inspected are noted in the report. If you desire information about areas that were not inspected, a further inspection may be performed.

Certain areas are recognized by the industry as inaccessible and/or for other reasons not inspected. These include but are not limited to: inaccessible and/or, insulated attics or portions thereof, attics where there is less than 18" clear crawl space, the interior of hollow wall, space between a floor or porch deck and the ceiling below; areas where there is no access without defacing or tearing out lumber, masonry or finished work; areas behind stoves, refrigerators or beneath floor coverings, furnishings; areas where encumbrances and storage, conditions or locks make inspection impractical; areas or timbers around eaves that would require use of an extension ladder.

Slab floor construction has become more prevalent in recent years. Floor coverings may conceal cracks in the slab that will allow infestations to enter. Infestations in the walls may be concealed by drywall or plaster so that a diligent inspection may not uncover the true condition/s. These areas are not practical for inspection because of health hazards, damage to the structure, or inconvenience. They were not inspected unless described in this report. We recommend further inspection if there is any question about the above noted areas. Re: Structural Pest Control Act, Article 6, Section 8516 (b), paragraph 1990 (j). Amended, effective March 1, 1974.

If an estimate or bid for making repair was given at the time of the inspection. "This company will reinspect repairs done by others within four months of the original inspection. A charge, if any, can be no greater then the original inspection fee for each reinspection. The reinspection must be done within ten (10) working days of request. The inspection is a visual inspection and if inspection of concealed areas is desired, inspection of work in progress will be necessary. Hidden damage is possible any time evidence of Subterranean Termites, Drywood Termites, Fungus (Dry Rot), Beetles, Faulty Grade, Earth-to-Wood contact, Dampwood Termites, Shower Leaks or Excessive Moisture is noted on this report. This Company is not responsible for hidden damage.
