### The Green Scene

The City of Indian Wells, in partnership with Burrtec Waste and Recycling Services offers Indian Wells residents a variety of trash and recycling programs to keep neighborhoods clean and minimize the use of landfills. Details are available at Burrtec.com (select Indian Wells) and CityOfIndianWells.org

#### Weekly Trash and Recycling

Burrtec collects trash and recyclables once per week. Backyard service is provided. Recyclables do not have to be sorted by type, but should be placed in the grey container.

#### Bulky Item Pick-Up

Residents can dispose of oversized items via this free collection service. (Limit of four items for free per pick-up; additional items \$10 each). To schedule, all Burrtec at (760) 340-2113.

#### Christmas Tree Recycling

Police and Eiro Emergencies

From December 26 through the second week of January, Burrtec will collect Christmas trees on residents' regular trash collection day. Trees must be cut into four-foot lengths or smaller, bundled and placed next to the trash containers. Unfortunately, flocked trees cannot be recycled and are destined for the landfill.

#### **Document Shredding Events**

The City sponsors four document shredding events every year in January, April, July and October to help prevent identity theft and promote paper recycling. Rules and limits to applysee website for details. Events are held at Burrtec's Palm Desert office located at 41575 Eclectic Street from 7 a.m. until 11 a.m. (Resident Benefit Card is required and a maximum of four banker sized boxes per vehicle will be accepted. No commercial businesses please.)

#### Household Hazardous and Electronic Waste

Burrtec will collect any household hazardous waste and electronic waste from your residence at no charge. (Limit of four items free per pick-up; additional items \$10 each.) To schedule, all Burrtec at (760) 340-2113.

#### Home Remodeling

Please consider donating, reusing or recycling the materials left over from your project. Fixtures, cabinets, flooring and other items can often be used by others. If the material is not suitable for donation, it may be recyclable. For details, please call the Indian Wells Recycling Coordinator at (760) 674-1032.


